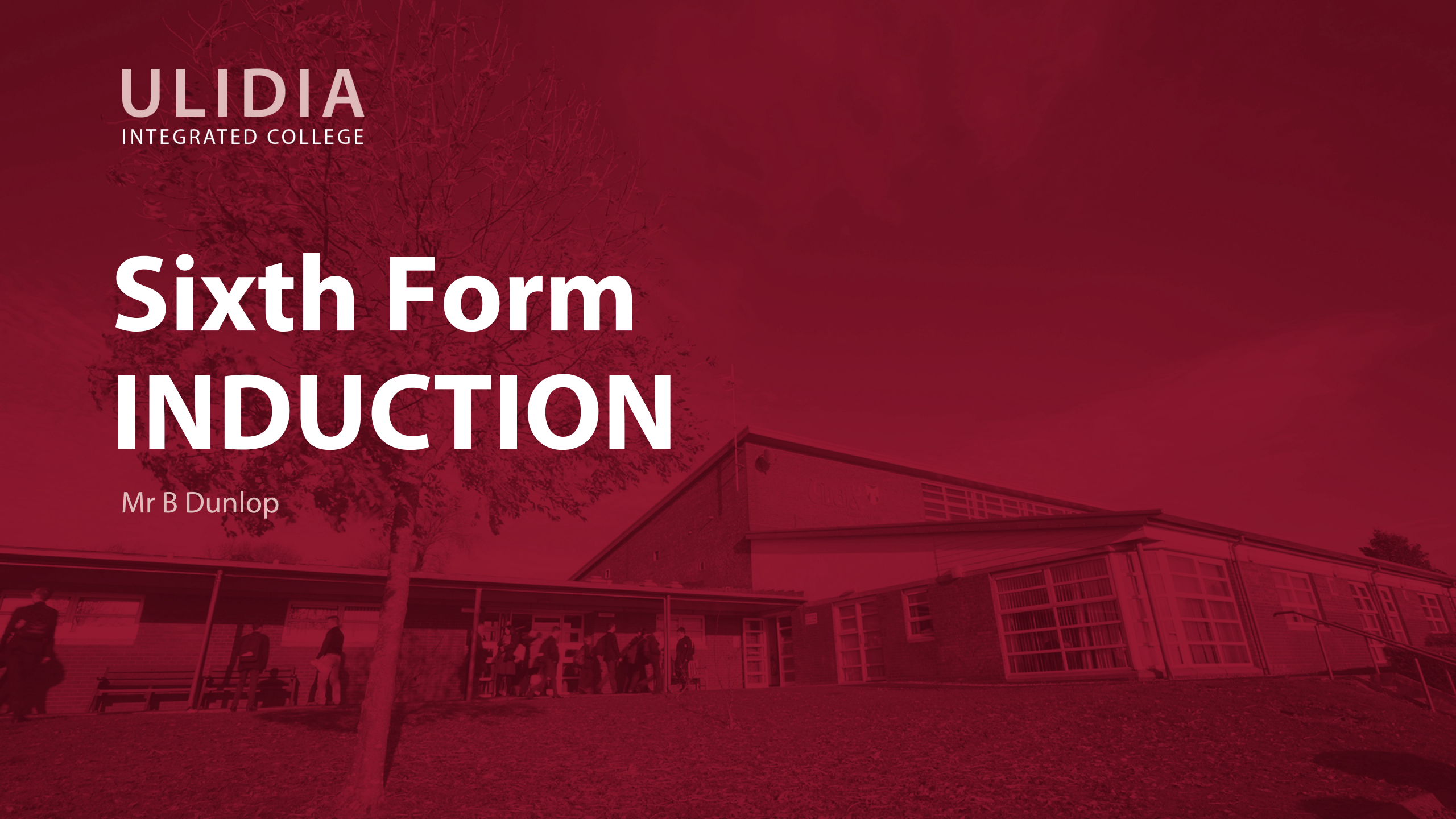

# ATTENDANCE

- Research suggests that:  
**17** days off school = **1** exam grade lower

The Five-Minute  
**Coach**  
Improve performance - rapidly



### OUTCOME, GOAL OR INTENTION

And what would you like to have happen?

### ACTIONS

And what needs to happen for [outcome in other person's words]?

And is there anything else that needs to happen for [outcome in other person's words]?

*Repeat this question a further 5 times or until you hear the first "no"*

And [outcome and recap every action point in brief]. And is there anything else that needs to happen for [outcome in other person's words]?

*Repeat this question until you hear the second "no"*

### GAIN COMMITMENT

And [outcome and recap every action point in brief], and what needs to happen first?

And can you [do the first thing]?

*Repeat this question until you hear the second "no"*
