 - Period 6 & 7: Science revision (except triple science & Horticulture)

Study leave

- Monday 22nd November to Friday 10th December
- Students should only be in school when they have an exam or a mock exam

For morning exams, be in school for 9am (9.15 start)

For afternoon exams, be in school for 12.30 (12.45 start)

GCSE exam rules

Pupils **MUST** :

- be in school 15 minutes before the start of the exam **AT THE LATEST**
- have a clear pencil case – we must be able to see through
- have a transparent bottle of water, label removed. No steel /coloured bottles
- have 2 or 3 black pens + all equipment needed for a specific subject
- have their candidate ID card with them to display on exam desk

GCSE exam rules

- Bring a smart watch or any other connected device in the Hall / exam room
